BACK UPS

Your data will be backed up automatically as part of your hosted solution. NOTE: Polygon Accounting users must run regular Database Integrity checks.

Go to File > Application Settings > Support > Run the Data Integrity Test. Print log and contact RedCat Helpdesk if any errors are displayed.
